Greeting Directors and Directress:

The Desert Youth/Isiserettes Department would like to applaud your hard work. Don't let your hard work be un-noted. We would like to award your Youth/Isiserettes Club with a beautiful trophy, should you submit an award-winning scrapbook. As well as Director/Directress of the Year Award, should you submit an award-winning report.

Scrapbook: Please get your pictures and articles ready to compete with other eye-catching scrapbooks across the Oasis. All photos should be labeled and dated. This scrapbook should cover the time period from June 2010 through May 2011. The size of your book should not exceed 12" x 12". Scrapbooks must be submitted at the time of registration. There will be only three ribbon (1st, 2nd, and 3rd place), so plan to take one back to your Youth/Isiserettes Club. All clubs participating will receive a Certificate of Participation.

Report: This report should cover the time period from June 2010 through May 2011. The report must be submitted at the time of registration. There will be only one Director and only one Directress of the Year plaques. All Directors/Directresses participating will receive a Certificate of Participation.

Three non-affiliated judges will be selected to judge the scrapbooks and reports.

ESSAY GUIDELINES

To be eligible, Essays must be unpublished and original work, at least 350 words long, and no longer than 1,000 words. The word count should be listed on the last line of the essay. Give your essay a title on page one and include your name, age, club name/Oasis and Directress's name. Each additional page must have your name, and you should number and staple the pages. All essays must be typewritten, word processed, or legibly written, on one side of 8-1/2 x 11-inch sheet(s) of paper.

Your essay should cover one, any combination, or all of these questions:

- What are Civil Rights?
- Are Civil Rights important?

In addition, all essays should include a quotation about Civil Rights, and explain why the quotation is important.

Your essay will be judged, "on your understanding of the uniquely American concept of Civil Rights." There will be 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place monetary awards presented. All participants will receive a Certificate of Participation.

ART GUIDELINES

Objective: To educate and inspire young artists by stimulating them to exercise their original creativity.

Age Participation and Eligibility:

Age: 3 – 6

Age: 7 – 12

Age: 13 – 17

Entry Deadline and Submission Information:

Art must be submitted at the time of registration.

Guidelines:

Standard-size paper is appropriate, either 8 1/2" X 11" or no larger than 20" X 18". **Entries submitted on paper larger or smaller than the specified sizes will be eliminated.** This allows each artist an equal advantage when interpreting his or her theme. Matted entries are acceptable, but matting is not required. **Give Art a title and include your name, age, club name/Oasis and Directress's name.**

Medium:

Pencil (graphite or colored), charcoal, ink, crayon, pastel, marker, and paints (watercolor, oil, acrylic, tempera, etc.) are acceptable. Computer-generated art will be eliminated.

Criteria:

Entries will be evaluated on the basis of originality, suitability, and interpretation of subject matter, creative technique, composition, and overall visual appeal.

Awards:

Award Ribbons will be awarded in appropriate age categories during a special ceremony at the Gala Day Youth Banquet.
